Yardage: 6,704 yards from Black tees; 6,215 yards from Blue tees; 5,684 yards from White tees, 5,173 yards from Gold tees, and 4,452 yards from Red tees.

Opened in 1998, Cattails at MeadowView in Kingsport quickly became recognized as one of the top public golf courses in Tennessee. The course, a Denis Griffiths design, features Bermuda fairways and Bentgrass greens, boasting picturesque holes that lie at the base of scenic Bays Mountain.

The links-style front nine at Cattails at MeadowView offers gently rolling terrain, combined with greenside mounds and bunkers. The back nine features a target golf experience meandering through the woods, highlighted by two memorable risk-and-reward par 5's.

Displaying a moderate number of sand bunkers, a winding stream, six beautiful lakes, wide fairways and large putting greens, it is a fair yet challenging test of golf. Five sets of tee complexes allow golfers of all skill levels to enjoy the challenge posed by this magnificent par 71 layout.
